The corrected sentence would be : **"The city has won multiple awards for being a green city."**

2. GROWN

Why correct: Spelled correctly and fits perfectly in the context — synthetic diamonds are "grown" (produced/cultivated) in laboratories under specific conditions.

3. PRESSURES

English meaning: The continuous physical force exerted on or against an object; force applied per unit area.

Hindi meaning: दबाव / दाब

Example: "Diamonds are formed under extremely high pressures deep within the Earth."

Why correct: Spelled correctly and used appropriately in the scientific context of describing the conditions needed to create synthetic diamonds.

4. TEMPERETURES

English meaning: There is no such word. The correct word is "**temperature**" which means the degree of heat or cold measured on a scale such as Celsius or Fahrenheit.

Correct spelling: **T-E-M-P-E-R-A-T-U-R-E-S**

Example: "Diamonds can only be formed at extremely high temperatures and pressures."

Why incorrect: The word is **misspelled**. The letters '**e**' and '**r**' have been swapped — "temper**e**tures" instead of "temper**a**tures." The correct vowel after 'temper' should be '**a**' not '**e**'. This is clearly a spelling error and makes it the incorrect word in the sentence.
